Dear friends,

You are all warmly invited to participate in the XIII World Congress of the Former Pupils of Catholic Education, which will be held in Lebanon from 24 to 27 November, under the theme "Former pupils of catholic schools: testimonies and agents of development, of dialogue and of peace"

Please find enclosed the programme and the booking form which we ask you to return urgently, duly filled up to the Secretariat of the Congress.

This XIII Congress is of utmost importance for OMAEC. It is the first to be organised in the Near East and after the first outside Europe which was held in Lima – Peru in 2002. We want to give our movement the real world dimension understood by its structures. On the other hand because it is held in Lebanon, referred by Pope John Paul Two as "It is more than a country, it is a Message!" This XIII Congress was decided to be held in Lebanon for a long time, but due to the situation in the World and in the Near East we had to postpone the event.

Lebanon is a small country, having as frontiers the Mediterranean Sea, Syria and Israel, temperate climate with temperatures about 18°C in April. Arabic country but pluralist having above 18 religious confessions officially recognized! Arabic, French and English are spoken. Cradle of the Phenician civilization, Lebanon, the only country referred to 72 times in the Holy Bible, is the bridge between the East and the West, a rosary of religions, creating a multicultural society. It overcame the dramatic war between 1975 and 1990, in the Middle East; henceforth its economic and social situation has suffered a lot.

It is in this context that we wish to approach the essential questions concerning the defence of the catholic schools, in countries where the economic situation handicaps its development toward the future; we, former pupils, cannot be indifferent to the difficulties these countries face!

I warmly thank the Lebanon Organizational Committee of this Congress, under the supervision of Nagy Khoury, President of FAEC, under the coordination of the President of OMAEC. We sincerely hope that there will be a solid representation of young former pupils and also a good representation from developing countries; we shall do our best to give them a financial support if necessary.

My best wishes, with great hopes to see you in Lebanon in November.
