Recent estimates indicate that 35% of women have experienced physical or sexual abuse by their partners or others throughout their lives. In the case of the Americas, the percentage is over 36%.

Today, there is still a third of countries that have not yet achieved parity in primary education, and many of them have a surprising number of girls facing violence and sexual harassment in schools And on their way to them.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Improving the use of technology, particularly information and communication to promote the empowerment of women, and ensuring universal access to sexual and reproductive health and rights Targets included in the Sustainable Development Program.
- We must fight and change attitudes that perpetuate the attitudes, beliefs and practices that generate cultural inequalities.
- Focus on finding ways to break the deadlock and accelerate progress on gender equality, both in society and within parliaments, which have only 22% of parliamentarians around the world.
- It is necessary to eliminate the so-called invisible economy of unpaid work from household tasks, which stops all economies and societies through the creation of more just societies and new sectors of employment, Closer to the formulation of new economic policies.
- Sustainable development needs greater investment in gender equality.
- It is absolutely necessary to free children and women from discrimination that are mired in many societies so that they can take advantage of their abilities.
- Recommend the inclusion of a gender perspective in all national policies (legislation, policies, and programs).
